BUCS Indoor Rifle Shooting Championships 2025

GENERAL RULES

Reference:

A. NSRA Handbook.

1. The meeting will be run under the rules of the National Small-bore Rifle Association (NSRA) and of British Universities and Colleges Sport (BUCS). Where there is a conflict between these rules, the latter will apply.

Range Committee

2. The Range Committee will be composed as follows:

D Froggett - Tournament Director and Chief Umpire

Representatives of BUCS shooting teams as required.

Officials

3. Range Officers - Representatives of Staveley R&PC

Teams

4. Teams are to consist of a captain and six firers. Team Captains may be firing members of their teams.

Prizes

5. For the team event:

- a. To the winning team: BUCS Gold Target Shooting Medals
- b. Runners Up: BUCS Silver Target Shooting Medals
- c. Second Runners Up: BUCS Bronze Target Shooting Medals

For the individual event:

- a. To the winning man: BUCS Gold Target Shooting Medal
- b. Runner Up: BUCS Silver Target Shooting Medal
- c. Second Runners Up: BUCS Bronze Target Shooting Medal
- d. To the winning lady: BUCS Gold Target Shooting Medal
- e. Runner Up: BUCS Silver Target Shooting Medal
- f. Second Runner Up: BUCS Bronze Target Shooting Medal
- g. To the winning novice: NSRA Small Gold Plaque
- h. Runner Up: NSRA Small Silver Plaque
- i. Second Runner Up: NSRA Small Bronze Plaque

Coaching

6. Coaching is permitted during team matches. (See Reference A Sec 2.1 Rule 6.9.8)

Squadding

7. The squadding plan, the draw and the timetable are shown on page 2 and the Main Noticeboard. All competitors are to ensure that their name and university are written on each card. If the competition includes more than one card in each round, cards are to be annotated 1, 2, etc.
8. Team Captains are to ensure that their team members understand and apply the squadding system shown on the Main Noticeboard.
9. *Within the Team Final, you may use an eligible substitute if you find that one of your team members is unable to shoot. A replacement shooter must already be entered into the event on BUCS Play, i.e. they must be entered into any of the three Individual Competitions or be from one of your other teams, they do not need to be someone who is competing in the Individual Final. You are unable to use somebody completely new that has not been entered or verified by your athletic union.*

Conduct of Shooting

Sticker application is to be observed and struck through by Range Officers or NSRA staff, if you do not comply, you will be disqualified.

10. Team Competition
 - a. There are six target lanes. Teams are squadded with a single competitor from each team in each detail. Each competitor will shoot a total of 2 cards in the detail. Times are as follows: 30 minutes is allowed for each detail.
 - i. Minutes 0 - 10 - Match card including sighters.
 - ii. Minutes 10 - 15 - Changing targets.
 - iii. Minutes 15 - 25 - Second match card plus sighters.
 - iv. Minutes 25 - 30 - Clear range.
 - b. Any number of sighters may be fired but the time limit per detail will not be exceeded.
 - c. A whistle will be blown during the last 5 seconds of the shooting period.
 - d. Each competitor will shoot two details of two cards, giving an individual total of 400 and a team total of 2400.
11. Individual Competitions
 - a. Timings are as follows: 30 minutes is allowed for each detail.
 - i. Minutes 0 - 10 - Match card including sighters.
 - ii. Minutes 10 - 15 - Changing targets.
 - iii. Minutes 15 - 25 - Second match card plus sighters.
 - iv. Minutes 25 - 30 - Clear range.
 - b. Any number of sighters may be fired but the time limit per detail will not be exceeded.
 - c. A whistle will be blown during the last 5 seconds of the shooting period.
 - d. Each competitor will shoot two details of two cards, giving an individual total of 400.

Range Organisation

12. Competitors are not to enter the firing point unless they are coaching or about to fire.
13. Competitors are to muster behind the range 5 minutes before they are due to fire. Team Captains are to ensure that their nominated firers reach this area on time. Lateness may lead to disqualification - **FIRING WILL NOT BE DELAYED**. Detail timings are tight therefore it is essential that competitors are ready in all respects to move forward as soon as the RCO allows.

Challenging

14. Results may be challenged up to 30 minutes after provisional scores have been published. A shot may be challenged once only on payment of a deposit of £2.50 per challenge to the Statistical Officer. The deposit will be returned in the event of the challenge being upheld.

Ammunition

15. Teams/individuals are responsible for providing their own ammunition. Team captains are to ensure that no ammunition is taken from the range. Team captains are responsible for ensuring all team members have removed all ammunition from the range.

Ties

16. Ties in team matches will be decided by the number of cards scoring 100. Ties in individual competitions will be decided by the score on the final card (fourth card in the Finals round). If still a tie NSRA Rule 5.5.5.5.5 will apply. <https://www.nsra.co.uk/competition-information>

Safety

17. Competitors are to ensure that their equipment is secure at times. **Firearms and ammunition security is the responsibility of the individual – DO NOT LEAVE FIREARMS OR AMMUNITION UNATTENDED.**

Notes
