### Men's Competition

Competition will start with 2 Pools, each with 3 teams where each team play the other 2 teams in their group twice. The teams selected for each pool are selected at random.

The top two teams in all pools get promoted to the playoffs in a Semi Final to Final Format. There will also be a 3rd place match for the losers of the Semi Final alongside the final to determine a 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.

Please see below the format for Playoffs:

**SF1 Court 1:** Group A 1<sup>st</sup> Place vs Group B 2<sup>nd</sup> Place

**SF2 Court 2:** Group B 1<sup>st</sup> Place vs Group A 2<sup>nd</sup> Place

**Final Court 1:** SF1 Winner vs SF2 Winner

**3rd Place game - Court 2:** SF1 Loser vs SF2 Loser

In the group stage a win is worth 3 points and a loss is worth 0 points. There are no draws in 3x3, with tied games at the end of regulation (10 mins) going to overtime with the first to score 2 points winning the fixture.

Ties in group stages will be settled using head to head results, then highest point difference, and then highest overall score.

Please note that the organisers reserve the right to change the formula to assist the smooth running of the competition and to improve the experience for the participants.

### Women's Competitions

Competition will be played in a single Round Robin/League format with all entered teams competing in one league. Each team will play every other team once during the competition. The league schedule will be created by the organisers.

As there are a limited number of team entries in the Women's competition, there will be no playoff stage. Final league standings at the end of all fixtures will determine the competition placings, including 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.

In the league stage, a win is worth 3 points and a loss is worth 0 points. There are no draws in 3x3, with tied games at the end of regulation (10 minutes) going to overtime, where the first team to score 2 points wins the fixture.

Ties in the league standings will be settled using head-to-head results, then highest point difference, and then highest overall score.

Please note that the organisers reserve the right to change the format to assist the smooth running of the competition and to improve the experience for all participants.
