

## **Lansdowne Local Rules**

### **1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18 Applies)**

- a) Beyond any fence bounding the course
- b) Beyond the white stakes at holes 9, 10, 11.
- c) Over the hedge surrounding the car park.

### **2. Bunkers (Rule 12 Applies)**

Please replace rakes in bunkers with the handle out against the lip.

### **3. Roads and Paths (Rule 16-1 Applies)**

All constructed roads and paths are immovable obstructions. Players are entitled to a free lift and drop. Rule 16-1.

### **4. Fixed Sprinkler Heads**

All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 16-1. In addition, if such an obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green of the hole being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty, as follows: If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a penalty area and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in the penalty area or on a putting green. Penalty for breach of local Rule 4:

Match play – Loss of Hole

Stroke play – Two Strokes.

### **5. Yardage Markers (Rule 15-2 Applies)**

150 yards distance posts measured to the centre of the green. Yardage markers are deemed to be movable obstructions and may be removed without penalty under Rule 15-2.

### **6. Young Trees (Rule 16-1 Applies)**

All staked trees are immovable obstructions, Protected trees, less than one club-length in height are immovable obstructions.

### **7. Aeration Holes**

Relief is granted should a golf ball come to rest in any aeration holes that have been made. The ball may be lifted, cleaned and dropped as near as possible without penalty or placed if the ball lies on the green.

### **8. Ground under Repair; Play Prohibited**

Please be advised that play is prohibited from all areas which are marked ground under repair (G.U.R). If a player's ball lies in this area the player must take relief under Rule 16-1.
