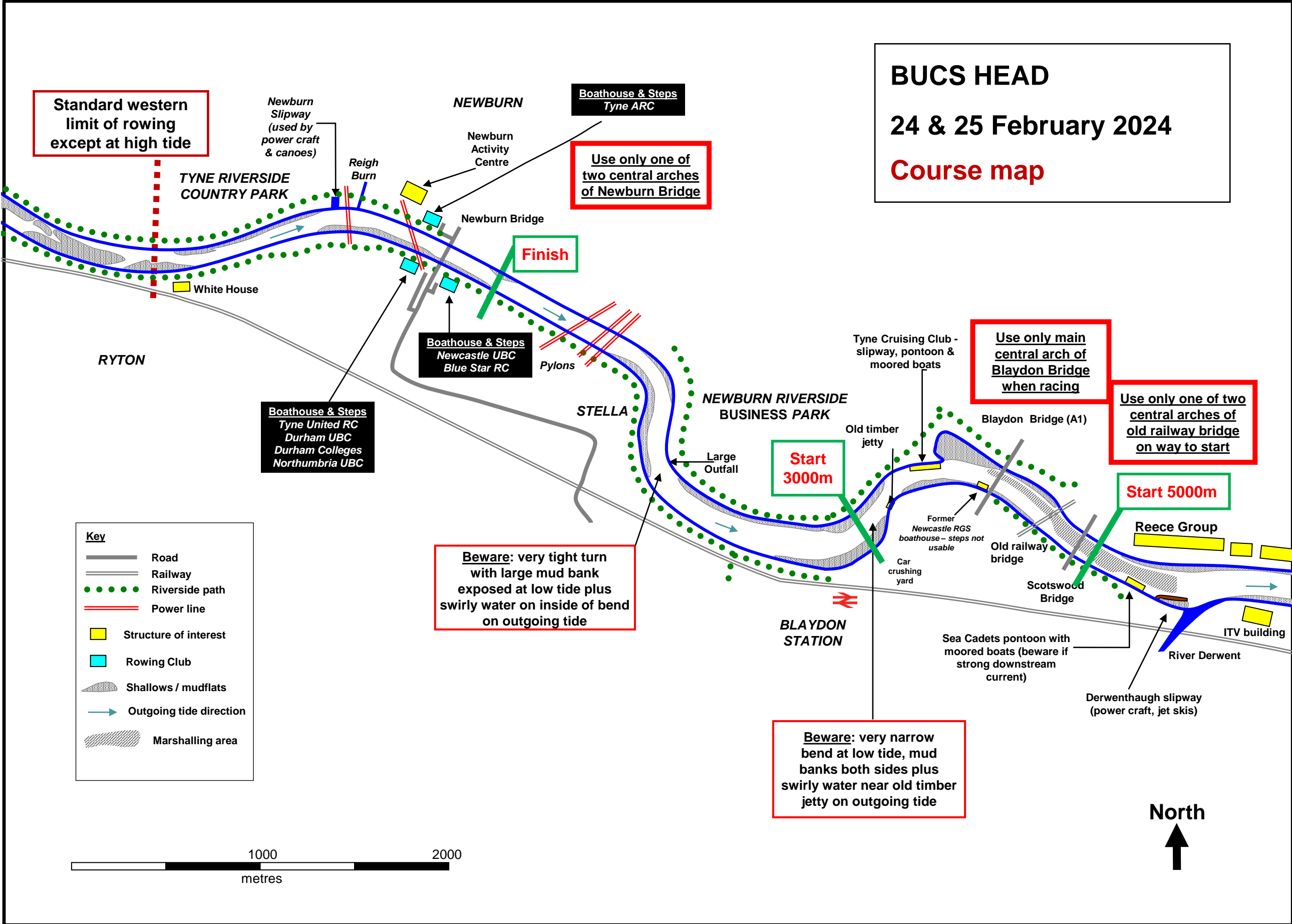

Use only one of two central arches of Newburn Bridge

NEWBURN RIVERSIDE BUSINESS PARK

Start 3000m

Tyne Cruising Club - slipway, pontoon & moored boats

Use only main central arch of Blaydon Bridge when racing

Use only one of two central arches of old railway bridge on way to start

Old timber jetty

Blaydon Bridge (A1)

Start 5000m

Large Outfall

Former Newcastle RGS boathouse - steps not usable

Old railway bridge

Reece Group

Beware: very tight turn with large mud bank exposed at low tide plus swirly water on inside of bend on outgoing tide

BLAYDON STATION

Sea Cadets pontoon with moored boats (beware if strong downstream current)

Scotswood Bridge

River Derwent

Derwenthaugh slipway (power craft, jet skis)

Beware: very narrow bend at low tide, mud banks both sides plus swirly water near old timber jetty on outgoing tide
