

BUCS REGATTA 2025

UPDATED 3 APRIL 2025 – now in Event Running Order

With thanks to those who contributed during the consultation period, the below is the schedule of events that will be offered at the 2025 BUCS Regatta, the first 4-day Regatta. It will be reviewed again after the 2025 Regatta.

Where possible the schedule follows the guiding principles below:

- Students are not expected to race on all four days and encouraged not to double up in the same day.
- Racing will start no earlier than 12:00 on Friday to alleviate additional accommodation requirements and allow for morning travel.
- Mix of event categories Championship / Intermediate / Beginner for open / women each day.
- Each boat class completed within a single day.
- Sweep and sculling events in a category (Championship / Intermediate / Beginner) scheduled to run across 3 consecutive days where possible.
- No 8s racing on Friday.
- Time for training on the lake after racing Friday/Saturday/Sunday.
- Minimum of 4 entries required for a boat class to run. **N.B.** Once entries have closed, there will not be the option to transfer into another boat class. Entries in an event not running will be rejected and not charged for.

Clarifications for 2025

- As per 2024, semi-finals will <u>not</u> be offered for Intermediate boat classes. This allows the opportunity for further finals to be added, allowing more people the opportunity to get a race.
 Semi-finals will continue to be offered for Beginner boat classes
- The lightweight single scull will be offered at Championship level only, which is open to all.



- In a change to previous years, subject to capacity, we intend to offer additional finals for Championship boat classes as below:
