TEAM SHEETS

Team sheet violations will not be tolerated from this point.

SCORERS & SCORESHEETS

Please note, some tournament directors have noted that not all teams have had a scorer and a scoresheet ready for their games. As per the indoor cricket regulations, each team is required to provide a competent scorer, scoresheet, and pen for all their fixtures on match days. Please ensure that for each of your fixtures you have a scorer, scorecard, and pen ready for the start of the match. Thank you!

BEHAVIOUR EXPECTATIONS

By attending a BUCS Indoor Cricket event, you are agreeing to adhere to all BUCS Rules and Regulations. Please be aware of the below:

Area	Student/Spectator
Alcohol/Drugs	All students and spectators must be aware that under no circumstances will any alcohol be tolerated at any events in any venues. Those found with either alcohol/drugs (including spectators) will be removed from the venue and will face disciplinary from BUCS and/or the police dependent on severity on the occasion.
Venue	All students and spectators must give full respect to the venue and the venue staff throughout the entirety of the fixture days. The venue must be left in the state that it was found in.
Staff	All students and spectators must give full respect to the tournament director and umpires throughout the duration of the fixture days. This is inclusive of all decisions made by the tournament director and umpires.

REPORTING ISSUES

Any issues must be reported through the team representative. They must be reported in line with BUCS Regulation 7. The team representative will be able to discuss the issue with the tournament director on the day. If the issue cannot be resolved, a BUCS Staff Member must be consulted. A BUCS Staff Member will be available by phone during the tournament and this number will be provided to the tournament director closer to the fixture date.

Please note that all decisions made by the Tournament Director or BUCS Staff Member are final.
