CHRIS POTTER STUDENT VOLUNTEER

This award celebrates a student volunteer who has contributed to university and/or community work. This can include working in domestic or international competitions, or performance or participation driven projects and programmes.

This award is shortlisted using the regional structure, with winners from each region being reviewed and narrowed down to a final shortlist for the overall award.

CRITERIA

Nominations must:

- Be a student at a BUCS member institution.
- A student who has gone above and beyond in their contribution to the student community between 1 May 2025 and 30 April 2026.

CONSIDERATION WILL BE GIVEN TO THOSE WHO CAN EVIDENCE THE FOLLOWING:

- Their impact on university performance programmes and/or clubs (40%)
- Their involvement with the development and support of intra mural sport and social participation initiatives (10%)
- Supporting with the planning and delivery of domestic and/or international events (5%)
- Working with the institution, NGBs and other partners to enhance the opportunities available to students and/or the wider community (10%)
- Providing Student Athlete Support (5%)
- Club development and support of university club committees (10%)
- Development and support of other volunteers within student sport (10%)
- Supporting the success of the university sport department or athletic union (10%)
