BUCS NETBALL SAG MEETING SUMMARY

1. Welcoming & Introductions

- · New members from Netball Scotland, Wales Netball, England Netball, universities, and student reps introduced their roles.
- · Continued collaboration across national governing bodies (NGBs) emphasized.

2. Key Discussion Areas

A. Venue & Facility Standards

- · Performance coach feedback highlighted the need for rule clarity on:
 - o Electronic scoreboards.
 - o Wooden sprung floors for top-premier leagues.
 - o Clear guidance on umpire identification and level.
- · Agreement to consult Charlotte (England Netball facilities lead) to align on reasonable and achievable standards. Action for KR
- · Recognised gap in shared understanding among club administrators about why these standards are set
- · Potential link to Sport England for overarching facility guidelines.

B. Workforce Development & Recruitment

- · Ongoing recruitment for new workforce positions, SAG South, Wales rep, and men's student rep.
- · Opportunities for education and skill-building within universities highlighted.
- · Consideration of better role clarity for club coordinators.

C. Policy Alignment & Competition Rules

- · Updates needed on trans policies
- Debate and review of the 50% rule for player eligibility, particularly:
 - o Impact on international athletes.
 - o Need for logging players who are in the squad but do not take the court.
 - o Potential exemptions and notification processes for unavailable players.
- · Examination of international player availability regulations and their effect on fixture rescheduling.
- · Need for strategic alignment with England Netball Super League and BUCS competition structures.

D. Fixtures, Scheduling & Player Load Management

- · Challenges with rescheduling due to international commitments.
- · Suggestion that games proceed without absent internationals to preserve league timelines.
- Recognition of high completion rates for netball fixtures (highest among major BUCS sports).
- Call for better load management and mental health support for student-athletes. Kath Tetley is creating load management guidance for universities. Netball Scotland can support mental health in universities with resources through their SAMH partnership.



E. Men's Netball Development

- Tristan to continue as BUCS men's netball representative.
- Men's BUCS tournament at Warwick: no facility costs, fees covering umpire costs; exploring use of two courts if entries exceed six teams.
- · Positive exposure of men's netball during recent showcase events.

F. Event Management & Communication

- Feedback from recent high-profile events:
 - o Miscommunication between volunteers and BUCS around live streaming and commentary quality.
 - o Need for high-quality media, promotion, and professional presentation on par with Super League standards.
- · Proposal to use university netball championships as a curtain-raiser for main events.
- · Importance of timely promotion, accurate event information, and strong social media campaigns.

G. Promotion & Participation

- Need for stronger social media presence from BUCS for netball.
- Suggestion to share performance stats and success stories to boost engagement. This is through the England Netball campaign
- · Use of polls and feedback forms with netball societies to strengthen student voice.

- o Katie Sykes & Sarah to meet Charlotte (England Netball) to set reasonable facility standards.
- o Clarify top-premier league venue requirements with BUCS.
- o Katie Sykes to follow up with Maz on NGB feedback process.
- o Katie Ryan to share "How to Score a Netball Match" YouTube resource.

2. Policy & Rules

- o Develop formal request to BUCS to record whether players took court for 50% rule reviews.
- o Review 50% rule in detail; draft potential exemptions for international commitments.
- o Review BUCS regulations on international player availability and rescheduling impact.
- o Investigate historical application frequency of international player rules.

3. Workforce & Governance

- o Advertise open positions: workforce, SAG South, men's student rep, Wales rep.
- o Circulate Performance South position advert to premier southern universities.

4. Events & Promotion

- o Obtain and review BUCS project plan for major events.
- o Explore university netball championships as a curtain-raiser event.
- o Follow up on umpiring course date releases.
- o Create infographic on BUCS netball completion statistics for promotion.
- o Increase direct social media engagement with netball societies and presidents.
- o Push for early and high-quality streaming and commentary for showcase events.
