This above scoring system (which replaces that detailed in SUR 5.2) was devised (in accordance with SUR 5.5) to account for the fact that when the Championships were due to start it was highly likely that it would not be possible to run all of the planned/normal rounds and/or to always progress the two surfers with the highest scores in each heat (SUR 4.12). This system was designed to make ties less likely, given that a large proportion of surfers would potentially be eliminated after round 1, if round 2 and/or round 3 had to be cut and the contest move straight from round 1 to the quarterfinals/semifinals/final, or that only round 1 may be possible.

How ties are separated (SUR 5.3 and SUR 5.4) did not need to be adjusted.

Where individuals are tied on finishing position in a heat, points are split according to their joint position and distributed equally to the joint institutions/Playing Entities. For example, if two individuals tie for 2nd place the points for 2nd and 3rd place will be combined and split equally between them.
