

BUCS CLAY PIGEON SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIPS

HOSTING REQUIREMENTS 2024-25

Status

The BUCS Clay Pigeon Shooting Championships consists of a two-day event where students from across the country compete to be crowned champion. Competitors compete as individuals with the top four scores per gender per institution extracted to form a men's team score and women's team score.

Clay Pigeon Shooting was first introduced at BUCS in 2002 and has since grown from strength to strength with its most recent competition hosting 260 students, both license and non-license holders, from around the UK. BUCS Clay Pigeon Shooting events tend to comprise of around 70-80% non-license holders, catering for beginners and the more experienced.

BUCS is seeking a host for the BUCS Clay Pigeon Shooting Championships 2024-25. The tender is for the 2024-25 season with an option to renew the partnership upon review for a multi-year partnership.

Format

Each competitor shoots 100 birds in squads of 6. Once a squad has started the competition, they work through the course in order of stands e.g. 1-2-3-4 etc.

A period of 2 hours is allocated to complete the course. There are no breaks permitted.

Dates

The event usual takes place annually on the first or second weekend of December.

Host Venue

The event can involve around 300 participants plus referees, event staff and any spectators. The host venue should be able to provide 100 targets per competitor, the number of stands depends on the venue.

The host venue should provide a cost per head in their bid questionnaire. The host venue will be financially responsible for the provision of all the areas listed in the bid questionnaire, unless stated otherwise. The cost per head should also cover:

- Venue Hire
- All referee fees and associated costs

Other financial models can be discussed with BUCS.
