Presentations will take place on Pitch 1. All presentations will be done after the conclusion of the Championship Finals. Where possible, we expect all teams receiving medals teams to attend. Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be award to all Teams. Where the competition does not allow for a 3rd place play-off, both losing semi-final teams will be awarded a bronze medal.

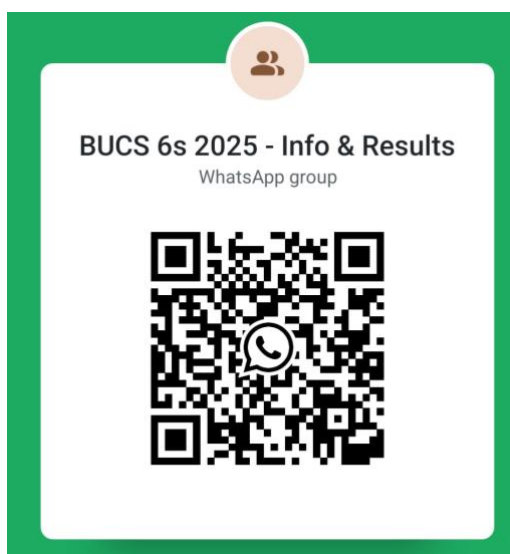
Registration: Registration will take place inside the reception area of the main “Leisure Dome” building. Captain/Coaches’ briefing will take place on the grass area in front of the Leisure Dome.

Please ensure you have registered your team’s arrival as soon as you get to site.

Team Sheets: Team sheets are not required for this event; however, all players must be registered on BUCS Play by **Tuesday 14th October**.

Squad sizes: Maximum squad size for BUCS 6's tournament is 12 players.

Parking: Limited parking is available on site.

Please note, parking for minibuses and large 52 seat coaches is **not** available on site. Please contact h.amos@englandlacrosse.co.uk if you intend to travel to site via minibus/coach and we will be able to advise a suitable drop off location and off-site parking.

Changing Rooms: Changing rooms will be available for use during the day at the main Sports Centre. Members of staff will be on hand to help direct you to changing rooms, however we would suggest teams come dressed ready to play. **All changing rooms are shared**, teams will not be allocated their own room, and changing rooms will **not** be locked. Please make sure you do not leave any valuables unattended.

Food: Mobile food & drink caterers will be available at the event hub, situated in between the two main buildings. Food & drink on offer will include:

- Coffee
- Wood-fired Pizza
- Indian Street Food

Equipment: Lacrosse equipment vendors will be on site with a range of equipment and accessories. The equipment vendors attending are:

- Pioneer Lacrosse
- Pulse Lacrosse

Medical Cover: Emergency medical cover will be provided at the event venue.

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Teams are expected to bring their own first aid kit with them to treat minor cuts/bruises. The Emergency First Aid team will be on hand in the event of any more serious incidents.

The First Aid team do not provide any physio or taping services.

There are no Physio services provided on site.

Warm up Area: Warm up areas will be available inside the 3G dome. **Please do not warm up directly behind goal areas.**

Playing surface: All fixtures will be played on 3G. Please make sure you bring appropriate footwear for the surface.

Playing colours & numbers: All players must wear a playing shirt or bib which is clearly numbered. The number must be visible on both the front AND back of the shirt. Teams must identify playing numbers on the team sheets, no number may be used more than once, and players **cannot** swap numbers during the tournament.

Where possible, please bring a set of different coloured bibs in event of a clash of playing colours. Where opposing teams are deemed to be wearing colours that are too similar, the first named team on the schedule will be required to change their playing colour.

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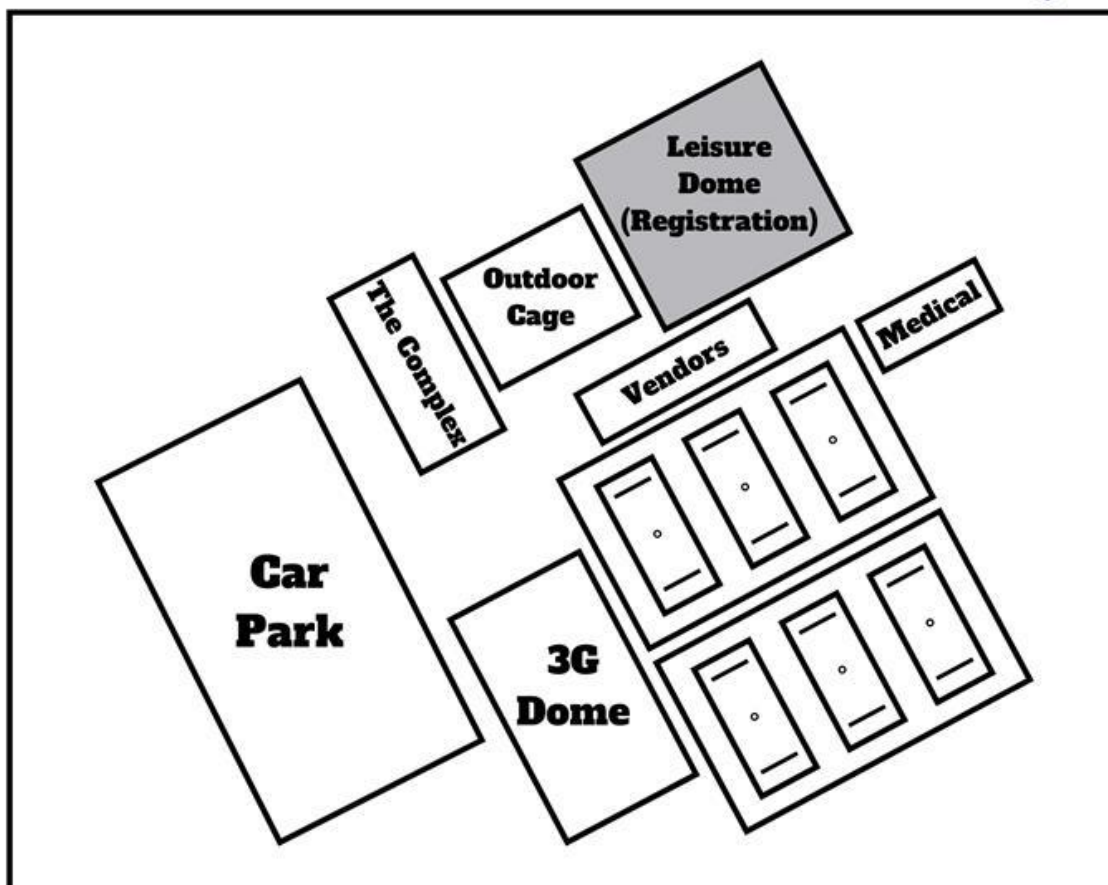
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BUCS Sixes Lacrosse Championships Site Map



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BUCS 6s 2025 - Tournament Rules

Games will be **7-minute halves, with 60s half time**

Turn-around time between games is **5 minutes**. Please ensure your team is pitch side & ready to play to start the match on time.

Game time, shot clock, and scores will be managed pitchside where possible.

No stop-clock to be played

No time outs allowed

Shot clocks will be managed by an off-field official/volunteer who will give a verbal count down when the shot clock reaches 10s remaining.

Points awarded:

Win	5 points
Draw	3 points
Loss	0 points
Bonus Point Loss	1 point if losing team scores 50% or more of the winning team's goals (eg 4-2)

If at the conclusion of the group stage two or more teams are equal on competition points for any position in the group, their position in the group competition table will be determined in the following order:

1. Head-to-Head result if two teams tied on points
2. Goal Difference
3. Goals Scored
4. Coin toss

Maximum goal difference to be accounted for in the event of a tie in points is 12. E.g a score of 15-1 would be adjusted to 13-1 to be used in the goal difference calculations.

Last 16/Quarter Finals:

No over-time will be played in L16 or quarter final knockouts. In the event of a Last 16/quarter final

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game ending as a draw, the highest ranked team coming into the knockout will be deemed the winner.

Semi-Finals:

Where there is a tie at the end of a semi-final, sudden victory (golden goal) overtime will be played. This will be played to a maximum of 2 minutes in 1 direction, followed by a maximum of 2 minutes after swapping ends. Teams are allowed 1 minute between the 2 periods. The team who scores the first goal will win the game and Over Time will cease. If no goals are scored during the 4 minutes of sudden victory over time, the highest ranked team coming into the knockout will be deemed the winner.

Finals:

Where there is a tie at the end of a final, sudden victory (golden goal) over time will be played. Overtime procedure will follow the same pattern as semi-finals (2min period, 1min change ends, 2 min period). All finals will continue to play overtime in this format until a result is achieved.

Cards & Penalties

Normal penalties shall be applied in accordance with the playing rules.

Red card penalties (straight red or fouled out) will be referred to Competition Lead and Lead official to determine any additional sanction(s) for player.
