1. To deliver a coaching programme for UWE Bristol Men's Rugby Team/Squads, with the aim to enhance consistency, raise standards and build strong pathways across the development squads.
2. To deliver inclusive and progressive training sessions, meeting the needs of the players.
3. To prepare and structure training in advance of the weekly session delivery, to work with fellow Coaching staff to provide and share best practice.
4. To support the Men's 2nd team at away matches.
5. To work with the Club committee and fellow Coaching staff to ensure smooth running of the Club, within the guidelines set by UWE Bristol Sport & The Students' Union at UWE.
6. To be responsible for ensuring that all sessions are run safely and report incidents, injuries and/or welfare concern.
7. To attend meetings when required and work as part of the UWE Bristol coaching team and share best practice – UWE Bristol meetings / Coaching Network Meetings | CPD Workshops.
