HAL OF FAME CRITERIA

Nominees must:

- Have competed in BUCS, BUSA, UCS (University and Colleges Sport) or UAU (University Athletics Union) competition for at least one year or attended a European Sport Games representing their institution or World Student Games as part of the GB Students delegation.
- Have made significant contribution to student, national or international competition in their relevant sport, far beyond that of their peers.
- Be superior achievers at the highest level of competition in a recognised BUCS or FISU (International University Sports Federation) sport.
- No longer compete in BUCS sport.
- Have made an "impact" in the sporting industry that goes beyond their physical achievements.

The Judging Committee:

- May consider a nominee who is part of a team on the same basis as it considers any individual nomination.
- Will consider the degree of difficulty for a nominee to attain the highest level of achievement.
- Will consider in addition to a candidate's individual achievements, that person's integrity, sportsmanship and character.
