ROLE PURPOSE

- Establish relationships between BUCS and Tier 2 & below member institutions
- Advise the BUCS Sport Advisory Group (SAG) on all matters relating to Tier 2 & below institutions perspective of BUCS Cricket.
- Help develop a strategic annual delivery plan encompassing Tier 2 & below institution feedback as one element of the plan.
- Attend all relevant SAG meetings and provide any updates on actions from previous meetings.
