## COULD TEAM CAPTAINS PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING AND BRING TO THE ATTENTION OF TEAM MEMBERS

Safety is the main concern, Could all team Captains or shooter responsible for teams, please ensure that rifles are made safe as soon as removed from their cases or gun slips. This entails fitting a breech plug or removing the bolt or action.

It would be appreciated if team Captains would ensure that the members of their teams are familiar with the details and courses of fire in use at the shoot. Each competitor will need at least 10 Bull dog clips

Range space is at a premium so **Please Ensure** full use of the firing points allocated to your University. You have the same firing points at 50mt and 100yds so both ranges can be used concurrently. **Shooting will commence at 9.00**. **There will be no additional details, shooting will cease at 4.50pm** 

Left handed shooters from any university should use the LH firing points No 26 and 27 According to the entry forms there aren't too many so there will be plenty of room.

Targets and backers will be available at the rear of each firing point, please use only the number of targets required. This is not an opportunity to stock up targets for the rest of the season.

The target numbers and wind indicators are for the convenience of competitors in furtherance of safe and more accurate shooting. They are not to be used for sighting shots or barrel warmers! Anyone found contravening this rule will be disqualified and the NSRA informed.

Should any problems be encountered during the course of the shoot please contact any Range Officer or any of the Officials on the range.

There will be a meeting of Team Captains / University reps. at some time during the day. An announcement of the time will be made during the shoot.
