Beeston Fields is pleased to welcome all BUCS Golfers. Please see some information on how they would like everyone to conduct themselves on the course and throughout the facilities.

**On the course**

- Flagsticks are to remain in the holes and not to be touched  
Inserts within the holes will be used so that balls can be retrieved without touching the flag
- Hand sanitiser will be available at the gates at the 9th/10th and 17th/18th. It is advised that only one person opens and closes the gates and uses the hand sanitiser before and afterwards
- The bells on the 5th & 12th holes are to be sounded by striking with a golf club (putter or iron). Under no circumstances are members to touch the bell. Clacker will be removed if possible
- If you do let a group through, please keep to the social distancing rules
- All ball washers and water fountains are not in use.  
Litter bins are available to put in your rubbish.
- The toilets on the course are closed

Bunkers: No rakes are out but most Bunkers are in play

In Play Bunkers – Pick and place is available. This is limited to 6 inches and the area cannot be smoothed before placing. Please try and smooth the bunker as best as you can after your shot.

## **Bar & Catering Service Guidelines**

It is with great pleasure that we are able to announce the re-opening of the bar and catering facilities on Saturday the 4th July 2020.

It is imperative the Government's social distancing rules are strictly observed. Our number one priority is to keep our members, staff and visitors safe, in addition to avoiding the risk of Covid-19 spreading. Because of the Covid-19 restrictions, services provided will be slightly reduced in terms of the range of food and beverages available to purchase, the hours of operation and taking full account of the Government Guidelines to make the club Covid secure.

In order that everyone can enjoy refreshments and a snack, it is vital that we all follow the operating conditions being implemented to ensure the safety of members, visitors and staff.

Please read the operating guidelines attached, take note and follow them along with any other request you may receive from a member of staff. (A copy of the full guidelines will be displayed in the bar).

You, collectively, will determine how successful this service will be and for how long the Club is permitted to continue providing this service. The Government's regulations make it clear that any failure to follow the statutory operating procedures and social distancing rules inevitably will lead to sanctions from the authorities. If we all follow the instructions and, above all, demonstrate care, consideration and common sense, then we can all benefit and enjoy this welcome next step in returning to a more normal enjoyment of our Club.

It is only with the support of the membership that we will be able to continue operating the bar and catering services, so we ask that you support it as much as you can while still adhering to the guidelines we are working under. We are confident we can work together to make this happen.

### **Operating Guidelines**

We are pleased to welcome you back to enjoy refreshments and snacks.

All members, guests and visitors **MUST** follow the guidelines below when using the Bar & Catering services from the clubhouse.

Following these guidelines is a condition of service without exception. Members not adhering to these guidelines or giving staff a hard time for doing their job will be denied service and or have their membership suspended for a month. We should all take this very seriously.

Please respect your fellow members, guests, visitors and the staff at all times.

The Government Guidance states: Indoor gatherings are limited to members of any two households (or support bubbles), while outdoor gatherings are limited to members of any two households (or support bubbles), or a group of at most six people from any number of households.

- Part of the guidelines to opening is collecting names and contact information to everyone using the Clubhouse facilities. We will therefore be asking for your name and contact information from everyone before being served. Obviously if you are a member we will just require your name. If you have guests with you then please have their names and mobile numbers at hand when ordering from the bar. All visitors will be asked for full details.
- There will only be 1 entrance to the bar and 1 separate exit. You must use the designated doorways which are clearly marked.
- Hand sanitiser will be placed at both doorways. Please use the hand sanitiser when entering and exiting. Sanitiser will be available at other locations as well.
- The front door to the clubhouse will be closed. You must use the entrance and exit from the bar.
- Please queue on the right-hand side of the bar in single file while keeping 2 m apart. Only 3 people in queue at any one time. Place your order with the bartender, pay by contactless payment and collect your drinks on the left-hand side of the bar. Your meals will be delivered to you.

- Tables **inside** the clubhouse will be limited to 2 people or up to 6 if from any 2 households (or support bubbles). Therefore a group of 4 golfers from different households cannot sit together at the same table. You will need to be social distanced with 2 sitting at an adjacent table.
- Standing around the bar or in other areas is not allowed. You must have a seat.
- The televisions will be turned off.
- If it is raining then unfortunately we will be limited to the amount of people in the clubhouse based on the rules above.
- **Outside** you can sit together while socially distancing in groups of up to 6 people from any number of households. You can also stand outside while socially distancing.
- Please respect other users and do not occupy a table for an extended period on busy days.
- Do not sit at a table that has not been cleared and disinfected. Please wait for a member of staff to get this done. Please be patient.
- Leave all glasses, plates and cutlery on your table. A designated staff member will clear the table.
- The main clubhouse toilets will be closed. You must use the toilets in the locker rooms.

We understand that this all sounds a bit harsh but these are the guidelines we are working under. They are designed to keep us all as safe as possible while letting us get back to some normality. We will review how we operate on a weekly basis and make any changes we deem necessary or if we get further guidance.

Let's embrace it and work together to get the best out of 2020 that we can.
