OVERVIEW

BUCS Nationals is returning to the City of Sheffield from the 13-15 February 2026. Taking place over four city centre venues over three days, we are expecting 4,300 student athletes to compete for BUCS titles over the six sports.

In addition to Karate Championships, Ponds Forge will also host Swimming. Elsewhere in Sheffield, the English Institute of Sport will host Indoor Athletics and Badminton. Right next door to there, the Canon Medical Arena will host Fencing. Climbers will be challenging their skills at The Climbing Works on Saturday.

ROLES

Scoring Assistant

 Helping to facilitate the operation of the bouts, by scoring or timekeeping, or any other reasonable duties as directed by the officiating team.

The Karate Championships takes place from Saturday 14 February to Sunday 15 February, and volunteers will be needed on both days. There will be morning and afternoon/evening shifts available on each day. We ask volunteers to be available for a minimum of 8 hours over both days. Volunteers will be provided with a BUCS Volunteer T-Shirt and snacks and refreshments whilst on shift.
