HQ & PARKING



HQ is located at Sewstern Village Hall, Main Street, Sewstern, Grantham, NG335RQ





Toilets are available in the HQ. Food / drinks for competitors are not available, you will need to bring anything you need with you.

Parking is only permitted in the designated car park behind the village hall, accessed via a gate to a grass field which will operate under a first-come-first-served basis. Should this become full, there are large grass verges on 'the drift' road heading towards the circuit.

You must **not** park on any of the village roads, as this will block access for local residents, who have been extremely supportive of the event. Anyone found parking on the village roads will be disqualified from the event.

SIGN-ON & BRIEFING

The HQ will open from 7.30am. Sign-on for the women's race will open from 07:30 and close at 08:30. Sign on for the men's race will open at 10:30 and close at 12.30.

You must present a valid student card and British Cycling race licence showing E123 category licence at sign-on to compete. No 4th category, or day licences are permitted for national B road races.

A race briefing will take place at the HQ 10minutes prior to each race (women's 08:50, men's 12:50). The race will be neutralised to the circuit (~3km), and started after the RIGHT hand turn onto the course.



COURSE

The race takes place on the rolling Wymondham circuit, with exposed sections, and short punchy climbs. The course last hosted the East-midlands regional road race championships in 2019.

FEEDZONE

The feedzone is located after the finish line with a grass verge for parking. Any riders taking on food must return empty packages to their pockets and not litter the course. Bottles should not be discarded.

NEUTRAL SERVICE

2 neutral service cars will be provided on the day, equipped with 4 bikes and 4 wheels. If you wish to make use of neutral service please bring additional spares labelled with your race number to the HQ prior to your race.

PODIUM & PRESENTATION

Podium presentations will follow the conclusion of each race at the event HQ.

BUCS medals will be awarded to the first 3 finishers in each event.

RESULTS

Provisional results will be available at the HQ following each event and posted to the Loughborough Cycling Academy social channels. Final results will be available via BUCSplay and British Cycling after the event.
