OVERVIEW OF MEMBER SERVICES

Member services are aimed to enhance universities' ability to use football to meet internal priorities o student experience, wellbeing and employability.

WOMEN'S LEADERSHIP PROGRAMME

The programme aims to unlock the potential of female university students aspiring to work in the Women's and Girls' game, to them become competitive when entering the job market.

WOMEN'S LEADERSHIP ALUMNI

Alumni programme aims to provide life-long support and mentoring to all Women's Leadership Programme graduates.

CLUB COMMITTEE LEADERS

Club Committee Leaders events have been designed to support university football and futsal committee volunteers and activat creating and/or sustaining positive cultures within their clubs, as well as giving them the opportunity to network and receive personal development to enhance their capabilities as a leader.

REGIONAL EVENTS

Regional events focused on understanding the importance of being a committee member and the legacy that can be created. Content also explored values based personal development in addition to a SWOT analysis of the university football/futsal club.

NATIONAL EVENTS

For national events we recommended that committee members bring a combination of both current and potential future comm for 2022-23 as a lot of the content explored supporting members with their long-term legacy and supporting the hand-over pr

Accreditation is an operating model which aims to unite the delivery of football under consistent standards to raise both the equality of access of football provision and the quality of that provision.
