SCHEDULE & FORMAT

📅 2022-23 UTC Round 2

- The 31 teams are split into 3 tiers of 8 teams (Cup, Pool & Bowl) and 1 tier of 7 teams (Shield). The Cup, Plate & Bowl tiers follow the same format below:
- The 8 teams are split evenly into 2 Pools of 4 Teams
- Teams will play all teams in their Pool during the morning games
- Teams are then placed into Quarterfinals based on their Pool position. E.g. 1st in Pool A plays 4th in Pool B, 2nd in Pool A plays 3rd in Pool B etc.
- Winners of the Quarter Finals qualify for the Semi Finals, losers qualify for the Play-Off Semi Finals
- All teams will play 6 games



Shield Format

- The 7 teams are split into 1 Pool of 4 Teams and 1 Pool of 3 Teams
- Teams will play all teams in their Pool during the morning games
- Teams are then placed into Quarterfinals based on their Pool position. E.g. 1st in Pool A plays 4th in Pool B, 2nd in Pool A plays 3rd in Pool B etc.
- 1st place in the 4 Team Pool will advance straight to a semi-final
- The 3 quarter-final winners will also proceed to semi-finals
- The 3 quarter-final losers will play a 3 Team Round-Robin to determine 29th, 30th & 31st place
- This guarantees all teams will play at least 5 games
- The day will end with a definitive ranking of all 31 teams

CURRENT STANDINGS

This event forms part of the National Championships, performance over all National Championship events will determine the number of BUCS points that are awarded to each team.

WITHDRAWALS

As of publishing this document, any withdrawals from the event will not be refunded. The schedule and format will not be revised and all the games relating to the withdrawn team will be recorded as 'Byes'.

REFEREEING

Player Referee slots will be allocated as per the Sport Specific Regulations. Due to the number of Full-Time Referees attending, it is likely that Player Referees will be required to facilitate the tournament.

Teams should ensure that their Player-Referees come prepared with a whistle. At event registration, teams will be required to mark who their Player Referees are on their team sheet. Player Referee Allocations will be completed nearer the time of the event.

Presentations will take place by the clubhouse where the following trophies will be awarded:

- Most Valuable Players (Female & Male) (as voted for by opposition teams)
- Most Valuable Referee

The ETA would be very grateful if as many teams as possible stayed for the presentations as this adds to the atmosphere and allows teams to celebrate together.

Nominating MVPs

After each game, team captains will be asked to nominate a female and male player from the opposition. These will be tallied up through the course of the event with the most nominated players receiving an award. This is part of the community we create in Touch Rugby and we think it is very important that this is celebrated.

EVENT CONTROL

Event Control will be located in the main common room of the clubhouse (green on the map). This will also be home to the referees. As a result, players are advised not to use the common room.

MEDICAL SUPPORT

Medical support will be located in the complex treatment room and at Event Control.
