

Local Rules

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2)

A ball is out of bounds if it lies: Beyond and fence, stone dyke or line of white stakes bounding the course

2. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR** (Rule 16.1)

Any area enclosed by white line. Playing a ball from area marked as GUR is prohibited.

3. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 16)

- a. Staked trees and tress protected by plastic tubing.
- b. Bells at 3rd and 10th holes.
- c. Ball washers, fixed rubbish bins and drinking water dispensers.
- d. Toilets behind the 10th green and to the right of the 12th hole.
- e. Halfway house behind the 10th green.

4. INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE

The cairn at the 17th hole and all internal stone dykes. The ball must be played as it lies or can be declared unplayable – Rule 19.1

5. **TEMPORARY LOCAL RULES** – See Notice Board

These rules will automatically become null and void at the end of the current golfing season unless extended by the committee.

6. LIFT AND DROP

- a. Players MAY obtain relief from DEEP impressions made by tractors.
- b. Relief may be taken from all paths at the nearest point of relief not nearer the hole.

PACE OF PLAY

It is recommended that you take no longer than 40 seconds to make a stoke (and usually you should be able to play more quickly than that). Ready golf in stroke play is encouraged.
