



Societies and Visitors - Social distancing guidance.

In these difficult times Longcliffe Golf Club is looking forward to welcoming you and your group and hopes that you enjoy your visit. To ensure that it runs smoothly, and that Government and England Golf guidance is followed, we ask you to ensure that the following expectations are followed in order to ensure that you and your colleagues remain safe.

Society organiser:

- Must inform all their visiting group of the following expectations.
- Organise groups and allocate tee times before arrival.
- Ensure that arrivals are staggered to arrive no more than 30 minutes before tee time.
- Provide any information/arrangements for each group to the pro shop staff so they can update each group as they arrive at the tee.
- Ensure that your group is informed and monitor them as they proceed.
- Following the visit inform Longcliffe should any member of the group show symptoms in order that we can inform staff and members who may have come into contact.

On arrival at the club

- Park in the upper car park
- Arrive no earlier than 30 minutes before your tee time.
- Social distancing procedures must be followed.
- Locker rooms are for the use of the toilets only.
- You must change your shoes in the car park.
- Remain in the car park until the group ahead have left the clubhouse patio, then meet your playing partners on the patio.
- When the group ahead have moved to the 1st tee, proceed to the Pro Shop area, putting green and practice nets.
- When the group ahead have left the 1st tee, move to the 1st tee ready to tee off.
- On leaving the course follow the one way system through the lower car park back to the upper car park.

On the golf course

- Maintain social distancing at all times. Keep at least 1+ metres apart.
- The flagstick must be left in and not touched.
- With rakes removed bunkers are to be 'raked' as well as possible using a foot or golf club.
- Do not touch any playing equipment including golf balls other than your own.
- All stakes defining penalty areas and the boundary of the course are to be deemed as immovable obstructions.
- Follow 'Ready Golf' pace of play guidance.
- From 4th July following the round golfers may visit the clubhouse and socialise in groups no larger than 2-6 from 2 different households in clubhouse and 6 from different households outside on patio

Clubhouse bar and catering

It is essential that these rules are followed to ensure social distancing and the safety of members and visitors.

Table seating is available indoors for 2-6 from only 2 different households socially distanced. On the patio table seating is available for up to 6 from different households socially distanced.

Golfers are required to remain in their 4 balls; required not to join together in larger groups; limit their time such that groups following are able to access a table.

Non golfers are required to follow the same guidance; sit at tables; limit their time such that others following are able to access a table.

One way system in operation.

- Wait at the disabled entrance. Check through window that parquet lounge queuing area is free.
- Move to the parquet lounge area when free.
- One person from each group to queue and order; others follow one way system to a vacant table. (showing green card).
- Follow one way floor markings to till.
- Place order and pay with contactless card.
- Pick up drinks order, card and receipt on tray at opposite end of bar.
- Food orders, cutlery and condiments will be served to the table.
- Return glasses, crockery etc. to tables at exit. Display red card to show that table has not been sanitised.

Standing or sitting at bar is not allowed.

Drinking and eating is allowed at all tables.

Use toilets located at disabled entrance.

Follow one way signs to exit via main door.
